



Dr. Carlos Chiale

Dr. Chiale is the National Administrator of the National Administration of Drugs, Food and Medical Devices (ANMAT), regulatory authority of Argentina.

The beginning of his service in public health traces back to more than 25 years ago. Dr. Chiale has fostered policies and mechanisms for the strengthening of regulatory capacities in Latin American countries as well as led regulatory convergence and harmonization initiatives within the framework of Mercosur, PAHO, and PIC/s, among others. Since 2008, he has presided over the Standing Commission of the Argentine Pharmacopoeia.

Dr. Chiale earned his Pharmacist degree at Universidad Nacional de Córdoba. He also holds a PhD in Chemical Sciences from the Universidad Nacional de Córdoba and was appointed Doctor Honoris Causa by the Universidad de Buenos Aires.
