Lembit Rägo, MD, PhD, is the Secretary-General of the Council for International Organizations of Medical Sciences (CIOMS) since April 2016. Before joining CIOMS, he worked at the World Health Organization (WHO) as a Head of unit of Regulation of Medicines and Other Health Technologies (RHT, 2013–2016) and Coordinator of Quality Assurance and Safety of Medicines team (QSM, 1999–2013).

During 1991–1999 he was Professor of Clinical Pharmacology at Tartu University and also the founder and first Director General of the Estonian Drug Regulatory Authority, State Agency of Medicines. During 2000–2016 he also served as WHO observer to the ICH Steering Committee, ICH GCG, IPRF and ICMRA.
