Dr. Lumpkin is Deputy Director, Integrated Delivery, and Lead for Global Regulatory Systems Initiatives at the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation since January 2014.

The Global Regulatory Systems Initiatives are focused on working with partners such as WHO (Geneva), PAHO, AFRO, regulatory regionalization initiatives, and NRAs in all parts of the world, to make more efficient and effective (without sacrificing product quality, efficacy, or safety) the regulatory processes through which health care products must pass to be developed, be eligible for procurement, and be legally marketed in low- and middle-income countries.

Before joining the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation, Dr. Lumpkin had been working during 24 years at the FDA, US successively as Director, Division of Anti-infective Drug Products (CDER); Deputy Center Director for Review Management (CDER); and Deputy Commissioner for International Programs

Dr. Lumpkin is a Medical Doctor. He holds a M.Sc. in medical parasitology from the University of London, UK, and a Diploma in Tropical Medicine & Hygiene from the London School of Hygiene & Tropical Medicine, UK.
