Beata Stepniewska is Deputy Director General, Head of Regulatory Affairs of the Medicines for Europe in Brussels (a member of the IGBA). In this position, she is responsible for coordinating regulatory and scientific activities, covering a variety of EU and international regulatory developments.

Having worked with the Medicines for Europe / formerly EGA since early 2002, she has been involved in expressing the position of the generic and biosimilar medicines industry to the European Commission, Parliament and Council as well as the CMDh, the EMA and National Competent Authorities on a number of pieces of legislation and on many regulatory guidelines covering scientific issues and operational and aspects of marketing authorization.

Before joining the EGA, she was Head of the Regulatory Affairs Department of PLIVA Krakow (currently a part of the TEVA group).

Before joining the generic medicines industry, she worked as a University researcher and lecturer at the Faculty of Pharmacy in Krakow (Poland) as head of Department of Pharmaceutical Law and Pharmacoeconomics. She is a qualified pharmacist.
